

I am a Kindergarten teacher and I really appreciate having books to use that give accurate information on topics I teach. This book does a super job describing the responsibilities of Presidents. We are even told that not everyone will agree with the decisions that the President makes and that the President will not always agree with congress (veto). The kids loved the part where the President's dog is in the newspaper because she had puppies. The use of children in the illustrations was appealing to my students. Preschool, Kindergarten, First Grade teachers should get this book!

This book is written from a child's perspective.... if I were the President I would... It goes through the main duties of a president in an interesting, clear way accompanied with nice illustrations. I loved that it explained in simple terms that the President does what he thinks is best (with help of cabinet..), but not everyone agrees. What a great first introduction for 4-8 year olds!
