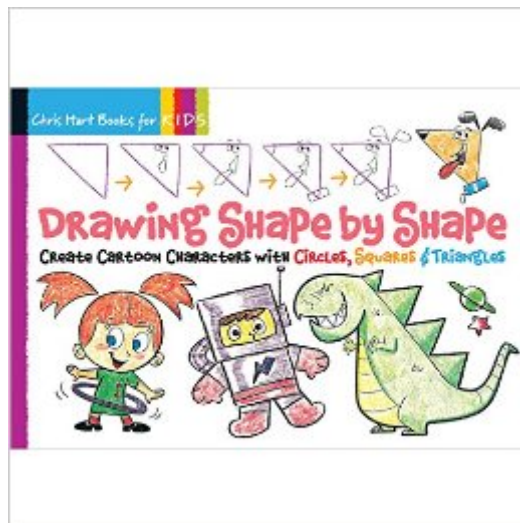

Fun and Simple, this book gets one inspired. Though I wish the templates we made out of something stronger, so that they would last longer, it was a good idea to put them in the book. All in all this is a great book and will make a great gift for an artist you know.

I bought this for my 5 year old son who loves to draw stick people. The figures are mostly simple shapes, but do incorporate other drawing to finish the figure. All in all a good book of good quality.

We have spent a lot of hours using this book and I love it. My daughter (7 years old) can create some surprisingly good cartoons with this book. I highly suggest it because it has good step by step details that can be followed and not like some of the crazy art books with 3 steps and a completed amazing drawing.

This cute book breaks down simple drawing into easy steps. First saw this book at Michael's, and bought one for my 10 year old grandson. Wanted another one for his 9 year old sister, and found it at the right price, with free shipping when combined with other items, at . They will be one of the gifts in their Easter baskets.

Great concept, learn to draw with basic shapes. The instructions are easy enough to follow, that my 5 year old was able to draw 6 of the characters without any difficulties. Would recommend for other aspiring artists.
