It's written with a font called Dyslexie (www.dyslexiefont.com) which is designed to make reading easier for kids like Hank who have dyslexia. Cons: If you were born before 1973, the name Henry Winkler will trigger a "jump the shark" flashback to the Fonz.

My 8-year old loves this book! She has dyslexia and the font helps her read fluently. It is amazing and a true answer to our prayers! I wish more books were printed in this font. We will continue to purchase every Hank book!
